Who must sign the application?

- Sole trader business – the sole trader.
- Trading partnership – all the partners.
- Limited partnership – all the partners, both the general and the limited partner(s).
- Non-profit association carrying on business activities – a board member or the managing director.
- Religious community carrying on business activities – a board member.
